MEMORANDUM

No. 03-Emp.—5th January 2005.—In terms of para-3 of the Labour Department’s notification No. 301-EMP., dated 21-08-2002, the persons belonging to the families of Land losers have been declared as belonging to the “Exempted Categories” for the purpose of the West Bengal Regulation of Recruitment in State Government Establishments and Establishments of Public Undertakings, Statutory Bodies, Government Companies and Local Authorities Act, 1999 (West Bengal Act XIV of 1999).

The questions of issuing clarification as to the compositions of such “family” have been under consideration of the Government for some time past.

It has been decided that for the purpose of enlistment of the candidates in the “Exempted Categories” of land losers as per procedure prescribed under para-A-3 of the Labour Department’s notification No. 303-Emp., dated 21-08-2002, “the family” will be regarded as comprising the following members.—

- 1) Land loser-himself / herself
- 2) Wife / Husband of land loser
- 3) Dependent sons / unmarried daughters of the land loser.
