RESOLUTION

In connection with the implementation of the Scheme for Skill Development for the Registered Job-seekers, introduced by the State Government in terms of Labour Department Resolution No.1502-GE dated 01-08-07, it has come to the notice that a considerable number of registered job-seekers intending to avail of the benefit under Part-1 of the Scheme were unable to come under the Scheme for non-fulfilment of eligibility criteria. After careful consideration, the Governor has been placed to make following changes at Serial 2 under Part-I of the Scheme:-

- i) A job-seeker will be eligible to apply for training under the Scheme provided he/she is registered with Employment Exchange for at least 2(two) years, instead of existing 5(five) years and
- ii) Minimum age limit to obtain training will be 20(twenty) years instead of 22(twenty two) years.

This order issues with concurrence of the Finance Department vide their u/o.No.188_Group 'L' dated 28_07_2008.
